d) For Consideration the Reorganization of Emergency Medical Services in Grant County.

Healthnet will be transporting all patients for Grant Memorial Hospital beginning October 1, 2023. This will have a financial impact on revenue acquired by the Grant County Ambulance Service. Grant County had a loss of \$3.8 million with the Ambulance Service since taking over the service in 2017. Beginning October 1, 2023, Grant County Ambulance will now have 24-hour coverage for 911 in Petersburg and 12-hour coverage in Mt. Storm. It has always been a goal for the Commission to provide 24-hour coverage on the Mountaintop. The concept was for WVU to take over the operating lease and transports at the hospital to reduce the burden on Grant County Ambulance. A meeting is scheduled for the Commissioners to speak to the employees on Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 9:00 a.m.

**10. Reports from County Commissioners**

Commissioner Miley would like to ensure that they are providing as much care to the citizens as they have been in the past. The goal is to be more efficient and effective and to save tax dollars when possible. For the last six to seven months there has been a battle with staffing and Grant County Ambulance has not been taking many transports. If Grant County excludes transports, then staff can focus only on 911 calls. There is always going to be situations but you rely on citizens of the community, volunteer fire departments and mutual aid companies to assist. We hope the public understands the true statistics because we have to be efficient and move forward. Grant County's Fire Department and EMS work hard and are willing to jump in and help anyone.

Commissioner Riggleman stated there is no price on a person's life and there never would be. Currently there is an average of three 911 calls and 2 transports per day. With WVU taking over transports, this will create a financial impact. We have reached out to different organizations for advice. It is a difficult situation to be in because of finances. There is currently no fees or levy in Grant County for the Grant County Ambulance service.

Commissioner Hagerly stated this is impacting the entire state with all counties looking for ways to save money. All Commissioners have been to Charleston to speak with Legislators, Senators, Delegates, and other EMS entities. Everyone is in the same boat. We want to make it as efficient as physically possible to not only the taxpayer but also to the sick and ailing. It is a fine balance to be found and change is tough. Hopefully a median can be found between the Commissioners and Grant County Ambulance after the meeting. The Commissioners have spoken to different agencies and anyone that could give advice regarding this issue. If nothing changes Grant County will go further in debt.
