



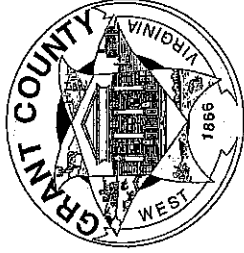

2022 National 4-H Week Grant County, West Virginia




